Felipe Duarte Olvera was appointed Undersecretary for Competitiveness and Regulations of the Ministry of Economy by the President of Mexico on September 17th, 2008. Previously he served as Technical Secretary for the Economic and Competitiveness Cabinet for the Mexican Government. In 2006 he collaborated in the transitional office of the President, on the delivery process of the Federal Public Administration. He previously worked at McKinsey Consulting and the Public Policy Office of the Presidency of the Republic.

Felipe Duarte holds a Masters in Business Administration from Harvard University Business School and a degree in Business Administration and Accounting from the Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México. He is author of the book "Cost strategic management as a basis for obtaining competitive advantage," published by the Mexican Institute of Public Accountants, A.C.
