MINISTER OF ECONOMY OF CHILE

Hugo Lavados is the current Minister of Economy of Chile. He holds a degree in Economics from Universidad de Chile and a PhD in Economics from Boston University.

He has an extensive experience in academic and business. He has been a consultant for several international organizations such as ECLAC, UNICEF, IADB and the World Bank. Between 1991 and 1993 he was president of the Working Group on the Internationalization of Emerging Markets.

He was Superintendent of Securities and Insurance, and one of the five members of the Antitrust Commission, during the administration of President Aylwin between 1990 and 1994.

Between 1994 and 1998 he was the General Manager of BHIF Bank, currently BBVA, and from 2000 to 2003, Partner Director of the "Transaction Advisory Services" Division of Ernst & Young Chile.

Between 2003 and 2006 he was Director of the Export Promotion Bureau ProChile, and since 2007, Director of the Center for International Business Development at the Universidad de Talca.
