### JOSÉ MIGUEL AGUILERA

#### *NATIONAL AWARD IN APPLIED SCIENCE, CHILE*

José Miguel Aguilera is Chemical Engineer (Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, PUC), Master in Science in Food Technology from MIT, PhD (Cornell University) and MBA (Texas A&M University).

He is a professor at the School of Engineering of PUC. He was Chief of the Chemical Engineering Department and Development Director (Vice-Dean) of the School of Engineering. He was recognized for his research on the effect that food structure has on its properties.

He is a consultant for the Research Center of Nestlé (Lausanne) since 1995 and visiting professor at the University of California-Davis and the Technical University of Munich. He has been a consultant for the European Union, FAO and SELA.

Hi is author of more than 150 scientific articles, 24 book chapters and 12 books. He has been awarded with the Guggenheim Scholarship, the Alexander von Humboldt Research Award and Marcel Loncin Research Prize from the U.S. Institute of Food Technologists. He received the National Award in Applied Science and Technology in 2008.
